## 7. Development Fund Requests

- **Men's Football, £500**

- Needed in order to help fund the 3<sup>rd</sup> teams transport for BUCS games.
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> team are currently top of their league.
- Have been fundraising via Quackback and the Cathedral Cup.

**Men's Football**

- There are 1,500 tickets to be sold for the match, and will be used as a fundraising event as clubs can sell tickets and for those who come to the game they will receive the money in their account.
- There will also be performances from Dance and Cheerleading on the night.
